CAMP REGISTRATION FORMS AND FEES:

- 1. Health History Form
- 2. Permission, Waiver & Release Form
- 3. Registration and Payment Form

We must have all three required forms completed plus a \$200 deposit to reserve your child's spot in our summer camp program. Refunds will be given with 30 days notice or a doctor's note. The full tuition payment (\$600/week) must be paid on or before the first day of your child attending camp. WHAT TO BRING:

- An inexpensive daypack/totebag to hold personal belongings.
- ◆ A folding/ camp style chair
- ◆ Riding clothes: comfortable tee shirt top and long pants (preferably riding tights, breeches or jodhpurs NO SHORTS.)
- Boots with a heel are required for riding. Boots or sturdy shoes may be worn at other times.
- Change of clothes (shorts, tops.) For safety reasons, sneakers <u>may not</u> be worn in the barn or around horses.
 - Swim suit, sandals or flip flops and towel for hot days under the sprinkler.
- Sunscreen is recommended.
- ◆ Daily lunch preferably in paper bags, labeled with camper's name. Lunch will not be stored in a refrigerator, pack ice packs if needed.
- Fridays will be cheese pizza day.
- Water bottle labeled with camper's name. Chilled water is available for refills.
- Phones are not to be out during camp, SDS is not responsible for lost or broken phones.

LOST & FOUND:

Please label everything! Try to label all of your child's possessions, including socks and underwear. Children will often not recognize personal clothing, and it is difficult to return clothing items if there is no identification. SDS is not responsible for lost, broken or stolen items.

SIGN-IN/ SIGN-OUT:

For the camper's safety he/she is to be signed out each day when they are picked up in the afternoon. Only those individuals who are listed on the Permission, Waiver & Release Form may sign-out your child (This includes mothers & fathers). If a person's name is not on your Release Form, they will not be allowed to take your child! Photo ID may be requested from all individuals planning to pick-up your child.

MEALS:

Campers need to bring a lunch every day during the week (except Fridays). The lunch must be in a paper/nylon lunch bag with your child's name clearly marked on it. Pack Lunch with ice packs if needed, no refrigerator available.
