### CAMP INFORMATION AND FORMS

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We are excited that you have chosen Silver Dollar Stables Summer Horse Camp. A positive camping experience can be one of the most meaningful events in a young person's life. Our goal is to provide a safe, fun and educational horsemanship program for ages 5 years and up.

#### **CAMP REGISTRATION FORMS AND FEES:**

1. Health History Form
2. Permission, Waiver & Release Form
3. Registration and Payment Form

We must have all three required forms completed plus a \$150 non refundable deposit to reserve your child's spot in our summer camp program. The full tuition payment (\$550) must be paid on or before the first day of your child attending camp. Please mail or drop off the required forms to:

#### **WHAT TO BRING:**

- ◆ An inexpensive daypack/totobag to hold personal belongings. Campers belongings will be stored on their chair (see below) during the day
- ◆ Riding clothes: comfortable tee shirt top and long pants (preferably riding tights, breeches or jodhpurs.)
- ◆ Boots with a heel are required for riding. Boots or sturdy shoes may be worn at other times.
- ◆ Helmets will be sanitized Monday, and camper will be responsible for them till Friday. (\$50 fee if lost) Or you can make an appointment before camp to be sized so you can order your own riding helmet.
- ◆ Sunscreen is recommended.

#### **NEW RULES:**

- ◆ Water bottle labeled with camper's name is required.
- ◆ A Lawn chair for your camper to use for the week, can be left at farm (stored outdoors) till Friday.
- ◆ MASK that fits correctly, covers nose and mouth.

#### **LOST & FOUND:**

Please label everything! Try to label all of your child's possessions, including socks and underwear. Children will often not recognize personal clothing, and it is difficult to return clothing items if there is no identification. SDS is not responsible for lost, broken or stolen items.

#### **MEALS:**

Campers need to bring a lunch each day. Lunch should be able to be stored out of a fridge, so pack ice packs if you need to keep it cool. We do not have a microwave for camper use. Campers will be spread out outdoors for lunch on nice days, or inside our indoor arena on rainy days.
